# DONATIONS

As a charity we do rely on the generosity of local people and organisations to enable us to continue the great work we do here. We are so incredibly grateful to each and every one of you that donates to the Foodbank.

We are currently in need of the following items: Washing powder capsules (urgently required), ladies' razors, tinned rice pudding, tinned custard, long life fruit juice, UHT milk, instant mashed potato, sponge puddings, jams and table sauces; tomato ketchup, brown sauce and mayonnaise. We already have plenty of: pasta, rice, soup, baked beans, pulses, tinned tomatoes, cereals and biscuits.

Food donations can be delivered to us at Cheltenham Elim Church on a Thursday between 11am and 3pm. We have various other collection points in Cheltenham located at: Tesco on Colletts Drive, Asda on Hatherley Lane, Waitrose on Honeybourne Way, Co-Op on Windyridge Road, Co-Op on London Road, and finally Sainsbury's Local on Cheltenham High Street. We have a newly refurbished area at our Main Centre at Cheltenham Elim Church where we can provide additional support to clients to be sure they have access to the help they need to get out of their current crisis and back on their feet.


Clients enter through the main doors at the front of the building and no longer around the back.
